StrengthsExplorer (languages available: English)

StrengthsExplorer® is a strengths assessment that assesses 10 talent themes for individuals and identifies each student's three strongest emerging talents. Upon completion of StrengthsExplorer, students will be provided with explanations of their top three themes and will learn how to capitalize on their success and discover what they need to do next to continue building on their strengths.

Benefits: Research has shown that engaging students in what they are interested in and where they excel will lead to the outcomes of better academic performance, higher test scores, and ultimately students' ability to reach their full potential after high school. The results provide explanations of these themes, strategies for capitalizing on each, and action items to help students gain insight into their greatest talents – natural patterns of thought, feeling, and behavior – to leverage in the classroom and in life.

Career Interest Profiler (languages available: English)

The Career Interest Profiler is a career interest assessment for students based on Holland's interest codes (which takes into account personality types).

Benefits: The results of the assessment include the student's strongest field of interest with definitions of all the Holland interest codes. Students can view matching careers and career clusters organized by the amount of preparation each requires.

Career Cluster Finder (languages available: English)

The Career Cluster Finder is a simple questionnaire that helps students discover career clusters that may be a good match based on activities that interest him or her, personal qualities the student has, and subjects the student enjoys in school.

Benefits: Once a student completes the Career Cluster Finder, top matching career clusters are made available for review to include the top three clusters the student is matched with and a ranking of all clusters with a percentage match for the student. Students can re-take the cluster finder at any time.

AchieveWORKS Assessments

Do What You Are (languages available: English, Spanish, French, and Portuguese)

The Do What You Are® assessment uses personality types to help students identify their natural tendencies and will suggest careers and clusters that might be a good match for a student.

Benefits: The results of the assessment provide students with a four-part personality type. Each of the four parts represents a personality trait that contributes to the student's overall personality type. This will help students gain confidence and greater self-awareness as well as insights that help them make better decisions and take advantage of their innate strengths.

MI Advantage (languages available: English, Spanish, French, and Portuguese)

The MI Advantage assessment uses Multiple Intelligences theory to reveal students' intelligence strengths and challenges, and then provides suggestions on ways to develop all of their intelligences. In addition, the results will provide students with career recommendations that align with students' intelligences.

Benefits: The results of MI Advantage include strategies to boost intelligences with low and medium scores. This assessment will empower students to develop and make optimal use of their strengths in the pursuit of goals and interests, both inside and outside of school.

Learning Style Inventory (languages available: English, Spanish, French, and Portuguese)

The Learning Style Inventory assessment allows students to boost academic potential by recognizing their natural learning style, discover better learning strategies, and gain career development skills. The assessment provides students with a report that can be used to increase understanding of the student's needs at school.

Career Key (languages available: English)

Career Key is a career assessment for middle and high school students based on Holland's interest codes. Career Key's scientific matching system enables students to identify careers and college majors that match their interests, traits, skills and abilities.
